

Publication Ethics – PECCON 2019

For paper Submission and Publication in Conference Proceedings:

1. All Papers should be in **Original (without plagiarism)** and should not be published in any other conference or Journal proceedings.
2. The authors are sole responsible for all the issues related to plagiarism. Authors are strongly advised to understand about plagiarism before submitting their manuscript.
3. The authors shall warrant that the manuscript have not been published, that they are not under consideration for publication elsewhere, that their publication is approved by all authors and if accepted, they will not be published elsewhere in the same form, in English or in any other language, including electronically, without the written consent of Springer Publisher and the organizers of the conference.
4. The manuscript will not be considered for publication, if the “declaration of originality”, and “Copyright” forms do not accompany the final manuscript. The authors should agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Springer Publisher or VIT Chennai or organizers of PECCON 2019 from any damage or expense that may arise in the event of a breach of any conference norms/ rules.
5. In any case, if the conference organizer or Springer Publisher receives complain about the originality of the author and it found to be true the paper will be suspended from the publication immediately.

To be sent along with review comments:

Authors are strongly advised to adhere to plagiarism before submitting their final manuscript. The overall similarity index should not be more than 20%.

Paper acceptance / rejection status :

1. Paper accepted in its original form
2. Paper accepted with minor revisions
3. Paper to be resubmitted with major revisions
4. Paper rejected
